Your case started directly in Supreme Court. **There are no Criminal Court papers.** In your latest letter you refer to the "sealing" of your indictment. **Your Indictment is not sealed.** As far as different copies of the Indictment: we did not provide you with copies, your family members made the copies themselves. There is only one Indictment. **We have no other documents to provide you with.**
