Petitioner MIGUEL DE LOS SANTOS, allege:

First: I am the above-named petitioner and I am familiar with the facts
and circumstances of the case.

Second: Petitioner is incarcerated and restrained of his liberty at Shawangunk
Correctional Facility, located in the County of Ulster, by Jaifa Collado,
Superintendent of Shawangunk Correctional Facility.

Third: The confinement of Miguel De Los Santos stands by virtue of a
commitment order. (See Exhibit A).

Fourth: That a court or judge of the United States does not have exclusive

jurisdiction to order the release of Miguel De Los Santos.

Fifth: That the cause or pretense of the imprisonment and restraint according to the best knowledge and belief of your petitioner, is certain commitment of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of New York committing Miguel De Los Santos for preliminary examination pursuant to a warrant of arrest under accusatory instrument number 3444-2002 (See Exhibit B: accusatory instrument), purporting to charge petitioner with the commission of murder in the second degree (P.L. § 125.25 (3)) [count two of the accusatory instrument]; based on the alleged crime of kidnaping in the first degree (1) (P.L. §135.25(1))[count three of the accusatory instrument]; and two counts of unlawful imprisonment (P.L. §135.10)[counts four and five of the accusatory instrument].

Sixth: Petitioner is a father of seven children, including a twelve [12] and eighteen [18] years old who need me. Petitioner is 62 years of age with no prior criminal record. Currently petitioner is at risk of contracting COVID-19 due to the higher than above average risk infection associated with prisons environment, which at petitioner's age could be a death sentence. Exhibit C shows that petitioner is not a violent person, was never seen in possession of a gun or knife, that petitioner did not murder anyone, doesn't have any criminal record, and does not

represent any danger to society. Also during his incarceration, petitioner was involved in different programs, such as floor covering, carpentry, general business, industry textile, and lastly working twelve hours a day filling bottles with hand sanitizer to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and all petitioner's evaluations are excellent (See Exhibit C).

Seventh: Petitioner has more than seven years in jail, and already has served a sentence for unlawful imprisonment in the first degree P.L. 135.10 count 4 and 5, and was sentenced to 1 1/3 to 4 years (See Exhibit A)[commitment order]

Eighth: But, count two [2] murder in the second degree (3), P.L. §125.25 (3), based on the alleged crime of kidnaping in the first degree (1) P.L. 135.25(1) Count three of the accusatory instrument, are unfounded crimes. The legislature states that no person shall be prosecuted, except for an offense as it described by legislature, which states that no act, or omission shall be deemed criminal, except by statute and any action by a grand jury other than those specifically authorized by statute are invalid. Kidnaping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1) statute, requires the intent to compel a third person to pay or deliver money or property as a ransom, (See Exhibit B)[accusatory instrument third count, kidnaping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1)] and that offense charged count three, is jurisdictional defective,

failed to fulfill the statutory requirement, failed to state any third person's name and failed to state to pay or deliver money or property as a ransom, and such failure was because the statutory element number six, never happened and no grand jury action was legally possible. The statute requires that "ransom demand" be made to a third party. Petitioner never compelled anyone, never demanded for any payment or money or property as ransom to anyone. There is not a single Appellate Division decision where the adjustment had applied to a defendant who did not intend for his demands to reach a third party. The accusatory instrument count three does not allege an offense described by Legislature, and that offense is unknown to the Law and our Constitution. and fails to allege facts to show the commission of that crime, and fails to supply reasonable ground for belief that petitioner committed the crime of kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25 (1) described by the Legislature, and by the statute without petitioner committing the statutory element of the crime. It is legally impossible to convict petitioner on kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1) third count because Exist jurisdictional impediment to conviction, therefore the prosecution was without statutory authority to present the kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. 135.25(1) to the grand jury and the grand jury lacked the authority to issue an indictment on kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. 135.25

(1)when no crime had been charged (See Exhibit B: accusatory instrument). The prosecution cannot create any right where none exist. The grand jury cannot take onto itself an authority or power not granted by the constitution or legislature.

Therefore no crime of kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1) was committed, and petitioner is entitled to immediate release, because that is the only offense charged that is holding petitioner in jail, and that offense charged does not constitute the crime of kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1).


Ninth: That no previous application for this writ of habeas corpus relief sought herein has been made by relator or by anyone on his behalf. Regarding the previous application, petitioner claimed that he was tried in a different theory than what was placed in the indictment, and it was dismissed because that claim was only for a new trial, and should have been raised on direct appeal or in a motion pursuant to CPL §440. However, petitioner's justification for a new application pertains to a different issue that requires immediate release, since petitioner already has served a sentence for unlawful imprisonment in the first degree P.L.135.10 that was 1 1/3 to 4 years, and the Court is totally stripped of jurisdiction upon the only charge that is holding petitioner in jail, kidnapping in the first degree (1) P.L. §135.25(1) and therefore failed to fulfill the statutory requirements made by the

legislature, upon that offense charged which not constitute the crime of kidnapping in the first degree (1).

WHEREFORE, Your petitioner prays that a Writ of Habeas Corpus be issued directed to Superintendent of Shawangunk Correctional Facility, Jaifa Collado, commanding her to produce the petitioner before Honorable Justice Karen K. Peters, at her chambers in courthouse located at 285 Wall Street, Kingston, New York 12401-3817, for a hearing and determination concerning the illegal confinement of Miguel De Los Santos and why Miguel De Los Santos should not be given his liberty and why he should not have such other and further relief as to the Court may seem just and proper.



It was also part of the conspiracy for [REDACTED] to obtain kilograms of cocaine and give them to RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS, who in turn would remit the proceeds of the sale of the kilograms of cocaine to MIGUEL DE LOS SANTOS.

It was also part of the conspiracy for RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS to give amounts of cocaine to ELLERMAN VALVERDE, JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA, and others, including J.D. Chacal, to sell to customers.

SANTOS, ELLERMAN VALVERDE, and JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA to assist [REDACTED] in the collection of narcotics debts.

OVERT ACTS

In furtherance of said conspiracy, and to achieve the objects thereof, the following overt acts, among others, were committed:

1. On or about September 20, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED], drove to a grocery in Kings County to meet Wilson Gonzalez and J.D. Rafael.
2. On or about September 20, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] negotiated the sale of five kilograms of cocaine to Wilson Gonzalez and J.D. Rafael.
3. On or about September 20, 1999, in the City of New York, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] delivered five kilograms of cocaine to Wilson Gonzalez.
4. On or about October 1, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] telephoned Wilson Gonzalez's brother in order to locate Wilson Gonzalez.
5. On or about October 5, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asked RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS to assist him in finding Wilson Gonzalez in order to collect payment for five

6. On or about October 6, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] went to 478 W. 145th Street, New York, New York, to meet Manuel Gonzalez.

7. On or about October 6, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asked Manuel Gonzalez if he knew the whereabouts of Wilson Gonzalez.

8. On or about October 7, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] DE LOS SANTOS, JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA, ELLERMAN VALVERDE, and J.D. Chacal met at an apartment at 514 West 135th Street, basement apartment.

9. On or about October 7, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED], RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS, JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA, ELLERMAN VALVERDE, and J.D. Chacal agreed to abduct Manuel Gonzalez.

10. On or about October 7, 1999, [REDACTED] [REDACTED], RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS, JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA, ELLERMAN VALVERDE, and J.D. Chacal went to 478 W. 145th Street.

NINTH COUNT

AND THE GRAND JURY AFORESAID, by this indictment, accuses the defendants [REDACTED] RAFAEL DE LOS SANTOS, JUAN PILNE a/k/a PUNALADA and ELLERMAN VALVERDE of the crime of CONSPIRACY IN THE SECOND DEGREE, P.L. §105.15, committed as follows:

from on or about October 7, 1999 to on or about October 8, 1999, with intent that conduct constituting the crimes of KIDNAPPING IN THE FIRST DEGREE, said crime being a class A felony, be performed, did knowingly and intentionally agree with each other and others, including J.D. Chacal, to engage in and cause the performance of such conduct as would constitute the above-mentioned class A felony.

OVERT ACTS :

In furtherance of said conspiracy, and to achieve the objects thereof, the following overt acts, among others, were committed:

6. On or about October 7, 1999, ELLERMAN VALVERDE entered apartment 33 inside 478 W. 145th Street.
